The Custodial Department is responsible for maintaining the cleanliness and hygiene standards of washrooms and general buildings including vacuuming, mopping, washing, and garbage/recycling pickup. This department regularly interacts with the public and are often relied upon to answer general inquiries.

The successful candidate will be required to:

- clean and sanitize washrooms including toilets, sinks, and other washroom fixtures
- clean staff and visitor areas in various buildings and restaurants
- collect, dispose of, and sort garbage and recycling materials
- vacuum, mop, and wash floors
- maintain and replenish stock in washrooms
- work efficiently while unsupervised
- respond to visitor inquiries by providing information about The Gardens
- report issues such as damaged or broken equipment to their supervisors
- assist with other jobs as required from time to time

The successful candidate must possess the following qualifications and demonstrated attributes:

- valid driver's license with clean driver's abstract
- ability to work independently and prioritize tasks effectively
- an excellent demonstrated understanding of how to provide exceptional visitor service
- good organization skills and attention to detail
- physically able to perform repetitive tasks such as bending, lifting and reaching

This is a seasonal position offering 32-40 hours per week from mid-November and ending January 6, 2026, with a possible return for our spring/summer season. Shift times will primarily be 1:30pm-10pm during our Christmas season and both weekday and weekend availability are required. Wage is starting from \$22.50 an hour.
